Even a tiny bit can kill a kid.



Store your medicine
**out of sight
and out of reach.**

- Keep in the original container.
- Lock in a box and/or cabinet.
- Rinse empties, put lids back on then dispose.
- Get naloxone – a full dose is safe for a kid overdosing on opioids.
- Don't store unlocked in the fridge.
- Don't keep in the car.
- Don't leave in a bag or pocket.
- Don't put in bottles or containers that could be mistaken for something else.
